DIVISION 7 - COOKERY Class 80 - SET RECIPE

Set Recipe - Chocolate Fudge Cake

For the cake

225g dark chocolate
 225g unsalted butter
 1 tbsp coffee granules, dissolved in 125ml boiling water and allowed to cool.
 175g plain flour
 25g cocoa powder
 1 tsp baking powder
 1/4 tsp bicarb of soda
 200g caster sugar (white/ golden)
 200g light brown sugar
 4 medium eggs
 75ml buttermilk (or add 1 tsp lemon to regular milk)

For the Filling

140g soft butter
 280g icing sugar
 1 - 2 tbsp milk
 1/4 tsp vanilla extract

Method

1. Preheat the oven to 140oC (fan)/ 160oC (conventional)/ Gas Mark 3. Grease and line 2 x 20cm cake tins.
2. Mix all dry ingredients together and combine well.
3. Melt the chocolate and butter and allow to cool slightly before mixing together.
4. Mix the eggs and buttermilk together.
5. Mix the chocolate, eggs and buttermilk and all the remaining wet ingredients until fully combined.
6. Add the wet ingredients to the dry bowl and gently fold together.
7. Cook the cake for 35 - 40 minutes and allow to cool.
8. For the filling- beat the softened butter for approximately 5 minutes until light in colour. Add the icing sugar slowly beating as you go.
9. Fold in the remaining ingredients.
10. Spread the filling on one of the cooled halves of cake and sandwich Together.
